



Kiruna's top 10 list

There are probably not too many places that are able to offer such a large variety of unique attractions as Kiruna. We don't want to brag, but as you will notice all these attractions happen to be the largest, deepest or most beautiful in the whole of Sweden, Europe or the world. These are actually only a few of all the places you can visit and things you can do, so we highly recommend that you stay for 'quite a while on your visit to Kiruna.

1. Kiruna Church

This church was voted Sweden's favourite building in 2001 and is well worth a visit. Prince Eugen's famous altarpiece, the inscriptions from Albert Engström along with Christian Eriksson's embellishments help make this church one of architect Gustaf Wickman's most beautiful works

2. Kiruna City Hall

This peculiar brick-square, with its wrought iron clock tower, was in 1964 chosen as the most beautiful public building in Sweden. Architect Artur von Schmalensee suggested naming it the Igloo, since the model for it was the Greenlandic igloo with its small entrance and a large central room. The City Hall has a beautiful interior and an extensive art collection and the building is open weekdays all year round.

3. LKAB InfoMine

The world's largest underground iron ore mine can be found in Kiruna. Mining on this large scale commenced towards the end of the 1880s, and the Kiruna city plan was approved by King Oscar II in April 1900. In effect, the mine created the city, and mining is still very important to Kiruna. Come along on the trips that leave daily throughout summer.

4. Mount Kebnekaise

Kebnekaise is the tallest mountain in Sweden, currently measuring 2104 metres above sea level. Initially the name, in various forms of Sámi describing a cauldron shaped mountain peak, was meant for the neighbouring mountain Tuolpagorni (1662 m.a.s). One theory is that the name Tuolpagorni is derived from the Russian word for "mountain pillar", possibly meant to describe Kebnekaise! Either way, Kebnekaise is the tallest mountain in Sweden, and a popular destination for many of Kiruna's visitors. It does however require some effort to reach! The road ends in Nikkaluokta, 66 km from Kiruna, and from there on you have another 19 km to hike until you reach the Kebnekaise Mountain station. After that another 10-14 hours of hiking and climbing remain, depending on which trail and which peak you choose!







5. Midnight sun

From the end of May until mid-July you can experience Kiruna in perpetual daylight! Sometimes you may find it hard to sleep, but on the other hand, why sleep when you can be up all the time? Experience the glorious nature of Kiruna round the clock!

6. Kungsleden Trail

The total length of the Kungsleden trail is approximately 440 kilometres, as this "king of trails" stretches from Abisko in the north to Hemavan in the south. For visitors to Kiruna we recommend a shorter route. Many visitors choose to hike from Abisko to the Kebnekaise mountain station and on to Nikkaluokta, a stretch of about 105 kilometres, estimated to take between seven and ten days for most people. If you prefer a one or two day hike, we highly recommend the suggestions found on another page in the travel guide.

7. Lake Trollsjön

The Rissajaure mountain lake, also known as the "Troll Lake", can be found furthest down in the long valley Kärkevagge, Stendalen. This is Sweden's clearest and purest lake with visibility all the way down to the lake bottom, 34 metres down. It is a beautiful half day hike, either on your own or with a guide from one of the mountain facilities. Lake Trollsjön is located in between Björkliden and Riksgränsen, just over 120 km from Kiruna.

8. Låktatjåkko Mountain Station

Låktatjåkko mountain station has the highest altitude of any mountain station in Sweden, 1228 metres above sea. It is about a 9 kilometre hike from Björkliden up to the mountain station and once you've reached it you will find accommodation with 18 beds as well as a restaurant. If you're not staying at the station it is the perfect goal for a day trip, but you can also spend the night and enjoy a nice dinner in the evening. If you are just visiting for the day, try the classic Låkta waffle before heading down again. Björkliden offers guided trips up to the Låktatjåkko mountain station.

9. Esrange

The largest civil sounding rocket in Europe is launched from Esrange, the space station located 45 kilometres from Kiruna. Since 1966 this has been the site of more than 500 rocket launches and more than 550 balloons have been released here. There are also two satellite stations that run, control and observe a number of polar and geostationary satellites. In summer there are daily guided trips to Esrange.

10. Björkliden golf course

Play on the northernmost golf course in Sweden located 103 km from Kiruna in Björkliden, and with the perpetual summer sun, you will really get your money's worth when paying your green fee. There are no guarantees that you will have a better swing here, but we do promise you a breathtaking aesthetic experience. Without a doubt, the golf course in Björkliden is worth a few extra swings.




Come along to the underworld!

Shopping i Kiruna

Kiruna offers a wide selection of handicraft, leisure and clothing shops. Buying a souvenir or gift to the people back home is for many an enjoyable and important part of their trip. If you are interested in buying handicrafts, you can find both the traditional; such as items made by the Sami people from natural materials, but also the modern equivalent made from local artisans using materials such as glass, ceramics, wood and textiles.

Many of the area's Sami artisans are represented in the oldest handicraft shop in Kiruna, Carl Wennbergs. Even if you are not after anything special, just setting foot in the 100 year old shop and taking in the atmosphere is an experience in itself. Today, the shop is run by the third generation of the Wennberg family.

Ateljé Nord is a handicraft collective with a shop in the city centre where you can browse and buy handicrafts, as well as meet the people who make the items as there is always at least one artisan in the shop.

Another handicraft collective, Máttaráhk-

ateljénord

ka, is located approximately 5 km north west of Kiruna centre, by the E10 road. There is also a café here, and anyone interested can book the Máttaráhkka relaxation area with sauna, hot tubs and dinner in the architect-designed facility.

Sven Hörnell AB is another handicraft and souvenir shop where you can also find paintings, books and postcards from the famous mountain photographer behind the name of the shop.

Kiruna Guidetur has a wide assortment of souvenirs. The Icehotel have a well-stocked souvenir shop, and there is also a somewhat smaller shop by Camp Ripan.

If you are interested in clothing with a modern Sami design, then a visit to Karin Vaasara's studio and shop in central Kiruna is a must. Karin has long worked with leather, fur and textiles and her clothes are worn today by royalty, entertainers and artists as well as by the people of Kiruna.


Kiruna also offers shops with modern interior design etc. for those interested in form and design. If leisure equipment for any type of activity is what you are looking for, then Kiruna offers a large assortment. There are hunting and fishing shops, as well as a number of sporting goods and leisure shops. It is actually possible to arrive in Kiruna without a stitch of clothing (but don't forget your credit card) and get fully equipped for both winter and summer activities.

You can also buy shoes, clothes, perfume and cosmetics, toys, flowers, food and drinks in the city centre.

If you are interested in locally produced food, a number of shops stock well-packaged reindeer and game meat products that can handle a two-hour journey back home and into your own refrigerator.

Sights in Kiruna & Jukkasjärvi

Kiruna

Hjalmar Lundbohmsgården

Get a look into the history of Kiruna through a visit to the home of the first managing director at LKAB. The home which is one of the oldest in Kiruna, today houses a museum with numerous photographs showing when Kiruna was built, as well as Hjalmar's office left untouched. Guided tours available all year round.

Kiruna Church

Kiruna Church was built in 1912 after the wishes of Hjalmar Lundbohm. He wanted it to resemble a Lapp cot which is why it today has a unique shape with light beaming in from above into an otherwise relatively dark interior. The altarpiece is painted by Prince Eugen, a friend of Hjalmar's. In 2001 the church was named Sweden's most popular building through all times.

Kiruna City Hall

The magnificent City Hall of Kiruna was designed by architect Arthur von Schmalensee and built in 1963. In 1964 it was awarded the Salinpriset, an award given by the Swedish Association of Architects to the most beautiful public building in Sweden. The characteristic clock tower was designed by Professor Bror Marklund and its 23 bells toll 3 times per day. The City Hall houses a large share of Kiruna Municipality's art collection and various exhibitions are often held here.

Máttárahkká

View and purchase beautiful traditional Sámi handicrafts here. Enjoy a cup of coffee while at the same time taking in the mountain views. You also have the possibility of booking a traditional sauna with both food and hot tub.

Samegården

Samegården is a centre for the Sámi culture in the municipality. This is one of Kiruna's more peculiar buildings, home to a historical Sámi museum. Cosy accommodation also available.

Sven Hörnell's slide show

Enjoy the magnificent nature of Kiruna Lapland through the camera lens of legendary nature photographer Sven Hörnell. View a photo slide presentation shown in Folkets Hus, Kiruna. The adjoining shop has handicrafts, photos and souvenirs for sale.

Jukkasjärvi

Jukkasjärvi Church

The oldest wooden church in Lapland, dating back to 1608. The famous altarpiece by Bror Hjort displays the Laestadian revivalism, as does the fantastic organ made from curly-grained birch wood and reindeer horn by famous craftsman Lars Levi Sunna that adorns the small church.


Nutti Sami Siida Culture center

Sámi open-air museum displaying Sámi culture past and present. Pet and feed the tame reindeer in the reindeer field. The handicraft shop sells Sámi handicraft and souvenirs and in the café you can enjoy a bite to eat by the open fire.

Icehotel Production

Venture in to the ice factory, where next year's Icehotel is waiting in the form of thousands of blocks of crystal clear ice. You are invited to travel on a fascinating journey into the story of the Icehotel!









Visit Kebnekaise - Sweden's highest mountain



Nikkaluokta is located only 66 km from Kiruna, and is easily accessed by car or bus.

From Nikkaluokta it is a further 19 km to Kebnekaise Mountain Station. To make the hike easier, it is possible after 5.6 km to exchange 6 km of the route by foot for a 30 minute trip by boat across the lake Ladtjojaure.

Once you reach the landing place with the boat, it is time for a snack break – try a fantastic reindeer burger at Lap Dånalds. After completing the boat ride, the hike continues another 8 km up a gentle rise towards the mountain station. Good overnight opportunities in both Nikkaluokta and at the Kebnekaise mountain station.

Those not wishing to hike up to the mountain station have the opportunity to fly by helicopter, which operates on set times in season. Other helicopter rides, e.g. over the southern peak of Mount Kebnekaise, can be arranged.

When hiking from Nikkaluokta to Kebnekaise mountain station, a detailed mountain map is not a must. For continuing hikes along the Kungsleden trail towards Abisko for example, or hikes in a southerly direction, the maps BD 6 and BD 8 respectively, are highly recommend. If you are planning to hike in the vicinity of Kebnekaise, the map over the Kebnekaise Mountain is very useful. Maps can be purchased at the Tourist Information Office, at Nikkaluokta Sarri as well as at the Kebnekaise mountain station.

Treriksröset

- The mound which separates Sweden, Norway and Finland

A very popular destination where you have the opportunity to be in three different countries at the same time.

In 1897 a mound was built by the Russians and Norwegians in order to mark the borders of the three countries; Norway, Russia (today's Finland) and Sweden. The hiking trail to Treriksröset begins in Kilpisjärvi, located approx 110 kilometres north of Karesuando after the E8 road on the Finnish side. The combined length of the route from Kiruna up to Kilpisjärvi is approx 300 kilometres by car.

During the summer season there are two ways to get from Kilpisjärvi and Treriksröset:

Hop onboard the tourist boat "m/s Malla" from Kilpisjärvi to Koltaluokta, which is an old Sami residence. The trip takes approx 45 minutes by boat. After that you walk the 3 km long path to the actual Treriksröset. There are bridges to help get you over wet areas. We

suggest you bring a lunch pack to enjoy by the stone mound. The boat stops by the shore and waits there for 2 hours.

You can also combine riding the boat and hiking. We then recommend that you catch the boat to Treriksröset and hike back. This way you get to enjoy nature and don't have to worry about being on time to catch the returning boat.

If you choose to hike the entire way to Treriksröset, there is a hiking trail that begins on the north side of the village. The route is approx 11 km long, at times through rocky terrain, so take your time...

Located 45 minutes from Kiruna is the Vittangi moose farm where you can encounter the king of the forest in his right element. An encounter we highly recommend. If you are hungry for lunch along the way, there are good

restaurants at Sopperogården in Övre Soppero as well as Kristallen Stensliperi in Lannavaara where you can also wash for gold and visit the mineral museum which houses the first diamond ever discovered in Sweden.

PLEASE NOTE! The easiest way to get to
Kilpisjärvi is by car. It is possible to travel by bus,
however this usually requires an overnight stay in
Karesuando.

The forest landscape of Kiruna - East Kiruna

Far from fast trains, crowds and built up areas and vastly different to the big city pulse and the grind of everyday life. This is where the fishing enthusiast will find sand glimmering currents of grayling and great salmon trout waters, gleaming red char and shapely salmon. The area offers a rich animal life, virgin forests, low mountains and swamps. The seclusion is palpable.

Visit the original mining village of Masugnsbyn with its 2.5 kilometre long, grand and impressive canyon. Should you not see any animals in the wild, there are other alternatives. Meet the great bull Foppa and the other moose at Vittangi Moosepark. If you instead want soft, cuddly draught dogs you can book a visit to Explore the North's Kennel for draught dogs in Kangos.

Furthest to the north is where you'll find the northernmost point in Sweden; Treriksröset. When you're here you are in Sweden, Finland and Norway simultaneously. Be sure to also visit Kristallen in Lannavaara. Try your hand at the art of stone cutting or gold washing, go shopping in the boutiques stocked with handicrafts and precious stones, or why not go on a guided tour? On your visit to Kiruna, be sure to take a tour of the imposing and vast forest landscape of Kiruna.

On the eastern side, travelling by your own car or by hire car is an excellent option. In this area you can find all you'll need as far as accommodation, food and petrol stations are concerned. Sure it is a bit "off track", but that is the idea

Fishing

For the confirmed angler, the municipality of Kiruna offers endless possibilities. With its 6 freely flowing rivers and 6000 lakes, you are sure to find waters to your liking. You can even try your fishing luck in the centre of Kiruna, in Lake Luossajärvi, where you'll find grayling and salmon trout. If a genuine wilderness experience and even more interesting fishing waters is what you are after, we recommend you contact one of our very capable flying and fishing companies.

If you are pushed for time, travelling by your own car is recommended. Following are a few quick fishing tips:

• Rivers Rautasälven/Kalixälven: Good flowing water, easy to get to. The Rautasälven river can be accessed from road E10 "Norgevägen" and the Kalixälven river from the road leading out towards Nikkaluokta.

- The mountain lakes around Abisko, Björkliden and Riksgränsen: A guaranteed beautiful nature experience. Should you also choose to venture further out on to the mountain, you will find complete solitude. If you feel unsure the mountain facilities also offer guided fishing tours to various waters.
- Southeast from Kiruna, along the rivers Lainioälven and Torneälven there are also very nice waters, perfect for fishing and canoeing in. In addition you can find pleasant fishing camps in e.g. Lainio and Rostujavri.

Remember that it is your obligation to know what fishing rules apply in the area. For information on fishing permits, please contact the Tourist Office.
